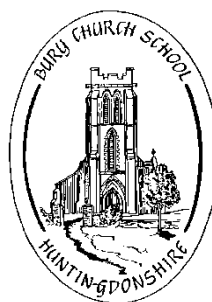

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) curriculum, and in line with our Relationship, Health and Sex Education (RSE) policy, class teachers will be delivering a series of lessons after May half term. These will cover a range of topics through the Cambridgeshire Primary Personal Development Programme. We feel that this scheme of work has been carefully designed taking into consideration age-appropriate materials which are well matched to meet the needs of our pupils at Bury CE Primary School. This curriculum incorporates the Relationships Education and Health Education guidance, whilst also supporting the Science National Curriculum. The sessions will be conducted in a safe, trusting and secure environment. Please see below the overview for each lesson:

When?	Title for lesson	Vocabulary
Lesson 1 Week beginning 7.6.21 (Sex Education)	To recognise the main external part of the bodies of humans, including names for sexual parts.	External body parts including hands, head, stomach, chest, teeth, penis, testes, vulva/vagina and bottom
Lesson 2 Week beginning 13.6.21	To describe what their bodies can do.	Range of action words e.g. run, jump, growing up as well as size, birth and death. Baby, child, girl, boy, male, female, man, woman, teenager, adult.
Lesson 3 Week beginning 20.6.21	To understand that they have a responsibility for their body's actions, and that their body belongs to them.	Range of feelings words e.g. happy, pleased, calm, sad, same, similar, different, unique, special, responsibility.
Lesson 4 Week beginning 27.6.21	To know how to keep themselves clean.	germs, disease, hygiene, tissues, water, clean, hygienic, external body parts. (See above.)
Lesson 5 Week beginning 4.7.21	To understand the importance of basic hygiene practices, e.g. washing hands, using a tissue, and how these prevent the spread of disease.	germs, disease, hygiene, tissues, water, clean, hygienic, external body parts. (See above.)
Lesson 6 Week beginning 11.7.21	To be able to understand what they have earned and to share it with others.	All of the above.
