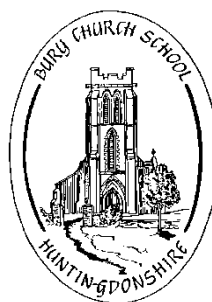

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) curriculum, and in line with our Relationship, Health and Sex Education (RSE) policy, class teachers will be delivering a series of lessons after May half term. These will cover a range of topics through the Cambridgeshire Primary Personal Development Programme. We feel that this scheme of work has been carefully designed taking into consideration age-appropriate materials which are well matched to meet the needs of our pupils at Bury CE Primary School. This curriculum incorporates the Relationships Education and Health Education guidance, whilst also supporting the Science National Curriculum. The sessions will be conducted in a safe, trusting and secure environment.
